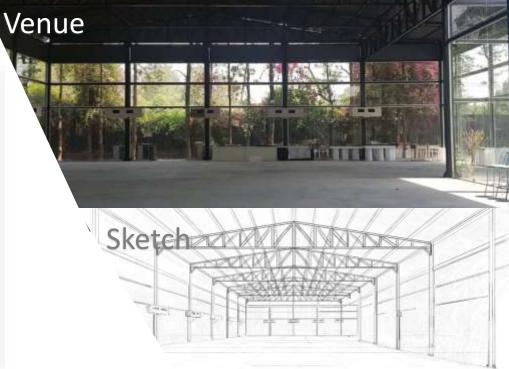


## Perspective Visual in Sketch

- These are second level of the design process.



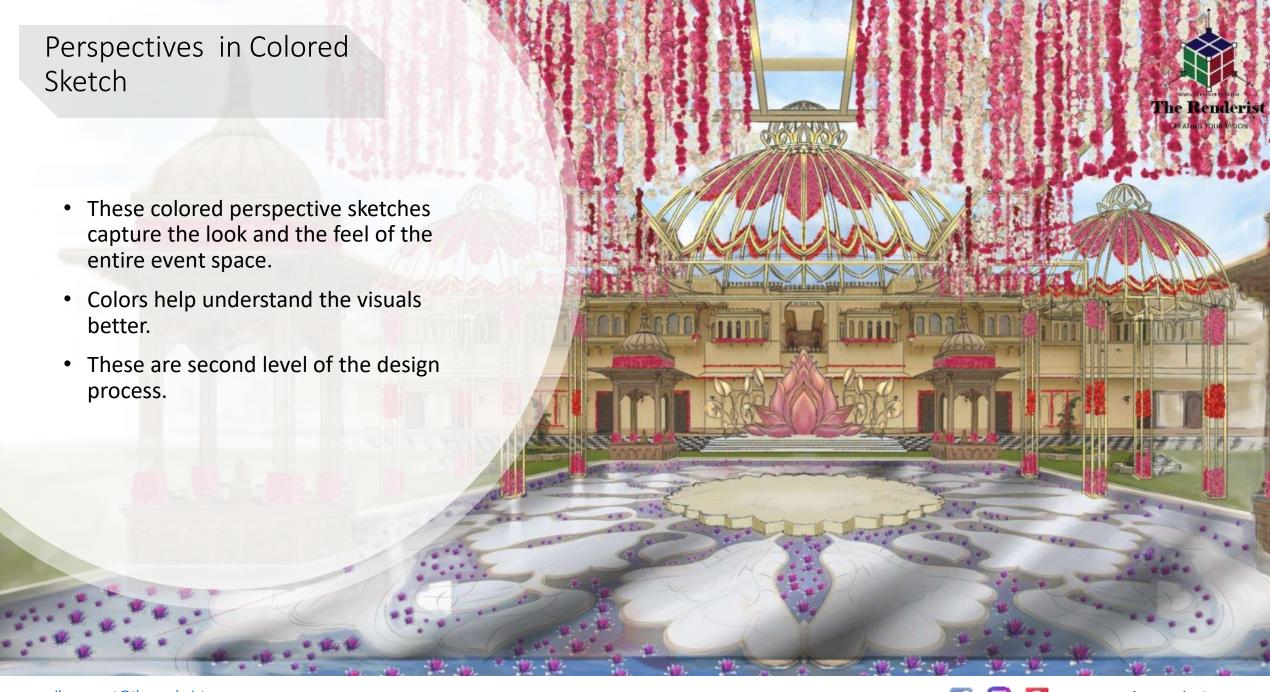










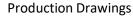


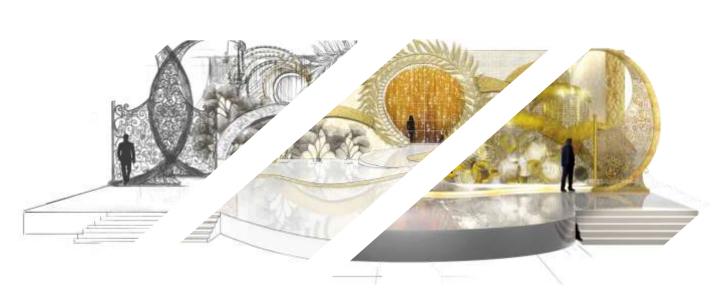


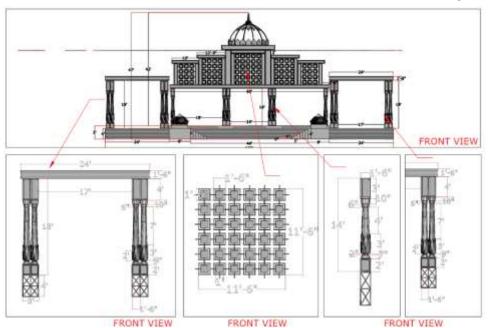
#### Elements in a 3D Render
